- When you file the written complaint, the GRC will offer both you and the public agency mediation. If mediation is not successful, the GRC can award attorney's fees to a complainant or impose a fine against a records custodian.
- There is no fee to file a complaint with the GRC.

To file a complaint in Superior Court:

The court will schedule a hearing to resolve the dispute.
